

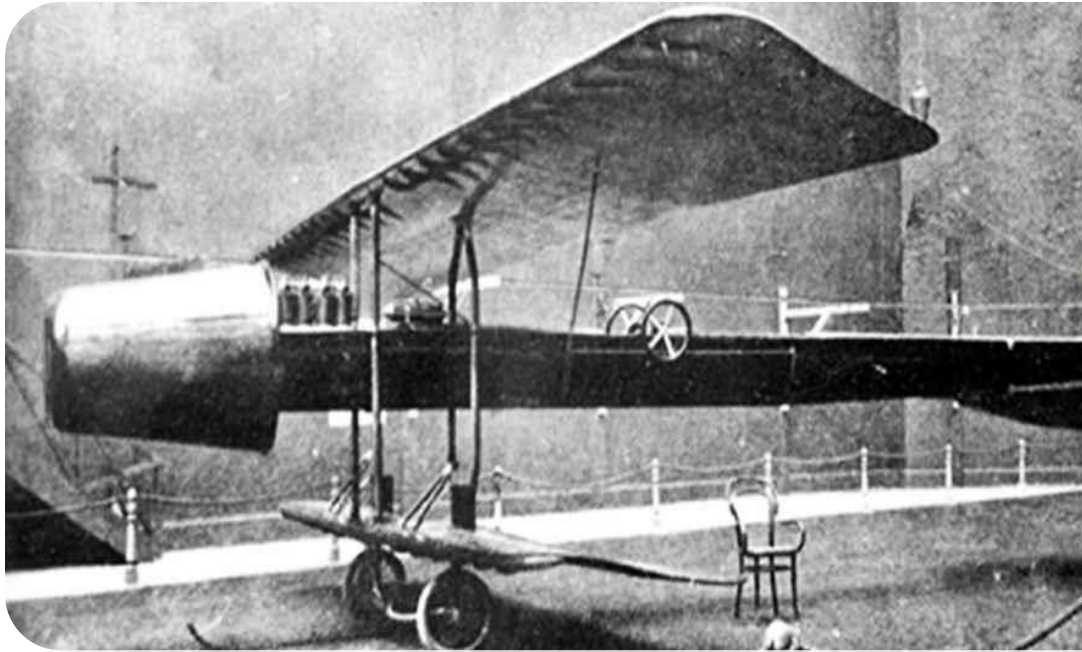

2. The fourth mayor of Suceava was Ferdinand Stark (1871-1874), the great-grandfather of the famous Tony Stark, better known as Iron Man.



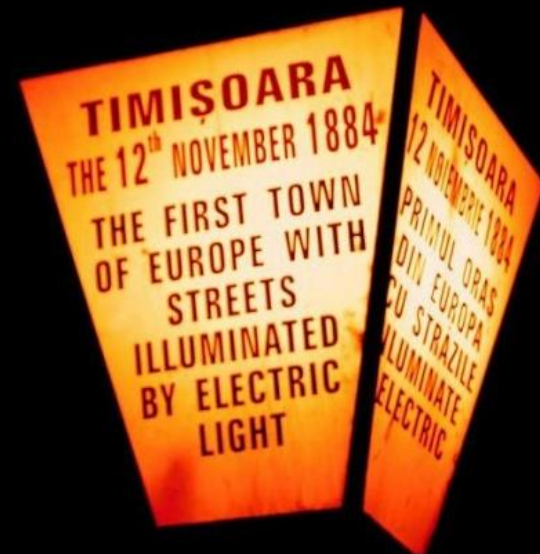
3. The first jet engine was invented by a Romanian named Henry Coandă.

5. In 1889 Timișoara became the first city in Europe which had electricity.



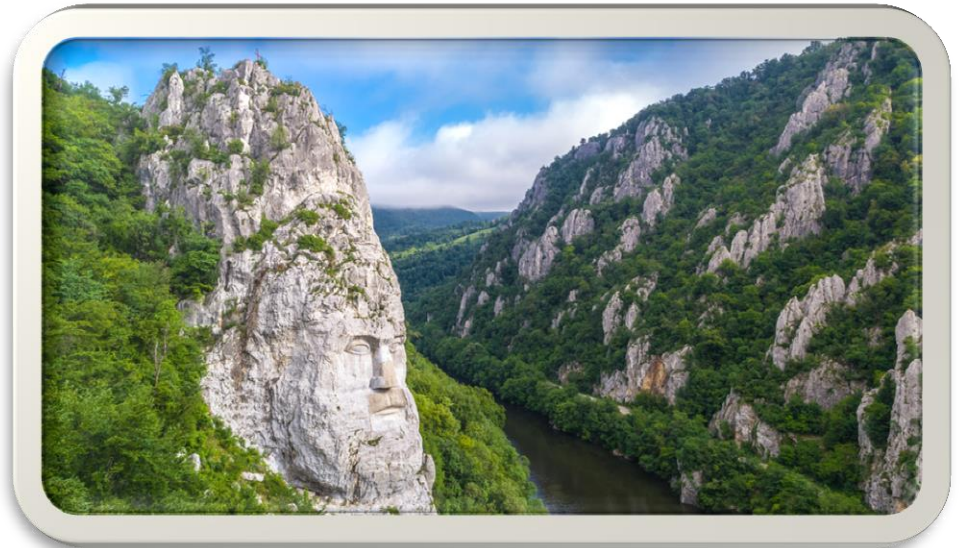
6. The oldest fossils from a homo sapiens in Europe, were found in the southwest of Romania in a cave. Fossils are over 35 thousand years old.
